RESPONSIBILITIES

- I. Serves as a non-voting member of the Board
- II. Coordinates nominations for (national) Academy awards
 - A. Consults President or Executive Director for a list of awards, deadlines and eligibility qualifications.
 - B. Requests nominations from the general membership and Oregon Academy Executive Board.
 - i. Develops newsletter, web page and social media messages
- III. Coordinates the selection process for the selection of the following Oregon Academy awards: (See Oregon Academy recommendations for Time Table and Selection Procedures in Policies and Procedures)
 - A. Recognized Young Dietitians of the Year (RYDY) Up to 2 awards given annually
 - B. Recognized Dietetic Technician of the Year (RDTY) 1 award given annually
 - C. Outstanding RD of the Year 1 award given annually
 - D. Emerging Dietetic Leader (EDL) 1 award given annually
- IV. Coordinates presentation of awards to RYDY, RDTY, EDL and ODY at Annual meeting
 - A. Coordinates recognition, including awards program content
 - B. Participates in the awards presentation during the annual conference
